- It is measured by a member's confidence that they have a realistic opportunity to enjoy those amenities when they matter most.
- The more members believe opportunity exists, the greater the perceived value of membership.
- Opportunity creates value.

Fairness Builds Community

- Demand will never be perfectly balanced.
- There will always be popular courts.
- Popular instructors.
- Popular leagues.
- Popular programs.
- Scarcity is unavoidable.
- Unfairness is not.
- Members are remarkably accepting of limited availability when they believe everyone has a fair chance.
- Fairness transforms competition into confidence.
- Confidence strengthens community.
- Community builds loyalty.

- Technology should never become the focus.
- Members don't care what software a club uses.
- They care whether they can play.
- Managers don't measure success by reservations.
- They measure success by satisfied members.
- Technology matters only when it helps clubs fulfill the promise they made when someone joined.
